COURSE DESCRIPTION

Emergency physicians from across the state of Wisconsin will gather at The Edgewater in Madison for the second annual WACEP Spring Symposium and 26th Annual Wisconsin Emergency Medicine Research Forum. This year's theme, Building Connections, reflects the importance of connectivity in the practice of emergency medicine and also highlights the joining of forces between WACEP and both the UW and MCW Residency Programs for a collaborate approach at the Annual Research Forum. Confirmed conference presenters include Erik Hess, MD from Mayo Clinic who will speak on patient involvement in shared decision-making; and Josef Thundiyil, MD, MPH from Orlando Regional Medical Center who will address the Orlando Pulse mass casualty incident.
